## *Pastor's Reflection*

Sometimes life sets its own pace. Lent is traditionally a busy season for pastors. We're preaching more, getting ready for Holy Week, and keeping everything else that we usually do up and running as well. I know spring is full of baseball and gardening and family plans and wrapping up school and everything else for many other people as well. We have things to do.

But then something happens. The pollen trips us up for a few days or weeks. A kid gets sick and the whole day is thrown off. The wifi goes down, or the car breaks down, or another one of life's little inconveniences takes our day in a direction we surely didn't intend for it to go.

When my daughter, Olivia, had the flu and stayed home for a week, I got to remember how differently time runs for children. Everything just takes longer. It was really frustrating, especially at first. When I finally gave up the idea that I should get to move at my pace, I started to see what was taking her so long. She noticed every little flower in the yard. She had to check on the cats before we left the house. She needed to know this, that, or the other thing to feel secure. She was moving forward, just not as quickly as I had hoped. Olivia helped me notice things about her and the about the places we found ourselves that I might not have on my own.

I wonder where God uses the small inconveniences of our lives to slow us down for a time. Where a sick day can become a chance to reconnect or to read that book we've been meaning to get around to. Where we can't get to a meeting and we are reminded that our presence is not always as critical as we think it is. God can use those little bits of time to slow us down, help us to appreciate the little details of our days, and call us back to him.

If nothing else, all those prayers for patience must be doing something.

In this Lenten season, we are called out of our own schedules, our own busyness, to focus ourselves once again on God. Wednesday nights become church nights, and Maundy Thursday and Good Friday will turn us again toward Christ. The great Alleluia of Easter morning is that much brighter when we have spent time in front of the cross.

I invite you, whether it's in group worship or in your personal time, to listen and look for those signs that God is there. Even if it wasn't on your first draft of the day's schedule.

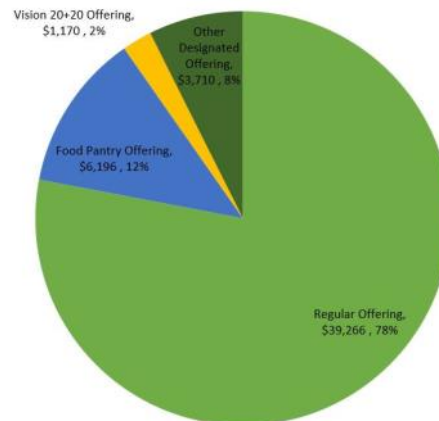

Did you know you can give online and electronically at Wittenberg? It's really easy – just follow these simple steps.

Open up the Wittenberg Home Page at [www.wittenbergleesville.org](http://www.wittenbergleesville.org)

On the left-hand side of the home page click on “Online Giving”

Click on the link “Click Here”

Add amount you want to contribute in the box by each category (i.e. General Fund, Vision 20/20, Food Pantry, etc.). The amount will Total automatically for you.

Click on “Donation Frequency” and choose “One Time” or “Recurring”. There is a link explaining how to set up the recurring selection.

Choose the “Date” you would like to make the donation or the “Start Date” if you are choosing “Recurring”

Select “Continue” at the bottom of the page

On the next page you will fill out your name, address, phone and email address.

Next fill out the “Payment” details. Payment can be made with a Debit/Credit Card, Checking Account or Savings Account.

If you would like to setup a “Profile” to use later click on “Select Password” so the 2 steps above will be automated in the future.

Click on “Process” and your donation is on its way. It's important to note that the site is administered by a third-party provider and meets all security protocols so your banking and personal information is secure.

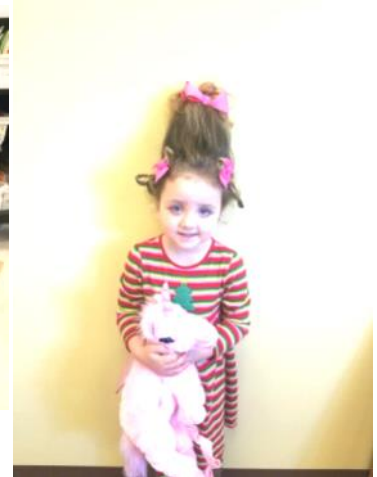
