## *Pastor's Reflection*

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

"We always thank God for all of you, mentioning you in our prayers. We continually remember before our God and Father your work produced by faith, your labor prompted by love, and your endurance inspired by hope in our Lord Jesus Christ." (1 Thessalonians 1:2-3, NIV)

Paul writes these words to a congregation of Christ's church that he loves. They could have been written today with Wittenberg in mind. I'm constantly amazed and grateful for the work that this congregation does.

Here is what is happening in your name, people of God:

- New speakers and upgraded equipment have been purchased and installed in the Sanctuary and Fellowship Hall so that we are able to hear, see, and share worship more easily and clearly.
- Your preschool is providing service to the community by giving our children a safe and welcoming environment so that parents can have peace of mind.
- Plans are coming together for Vacation Bible School.
- The South Carolina Synod is hosting Synod Assembly this month, at which we will elect a new bishop, among other agenda items.

This isn't your pastor's work alone, not by a long shot. This is also not a complete list. This is the work of your staff, your leaders, and all of you, the people of God. This has been made possible by your prayers, your time, your thoughtfulness, and your financial gifts to support God's work through Wittenberg Lutheran Church.

I am grateful for the work that I see happening because of you. I thank God for what God is doing with our hands and resources. Thank you for all the ways that you are part of this ministry.

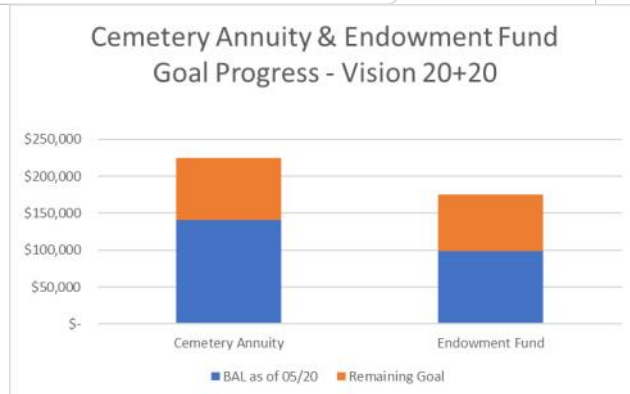
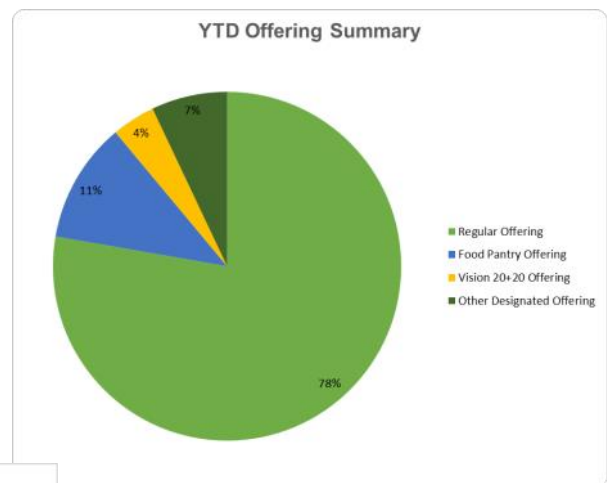
